

Minutes of the Club Member's Meeting
July 4th, 2020

(Meeting held on the 100 Yard Range during the Club's Independence Day celebration)

Opening: President Joe Ruth called the meeting to order at 8:54 am and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Attendance: 20 Members and 5 Guests were in attendance. A quorum of 5% of the membership was established.

Minutes: The Membership Minutes for the March 4th 2020 Membership Meeting were presented by Pres. Ruth for approval. With no amendments or corrections noted, a motion was made, seconded and passed unanimously to approve the Minutes.

Membership: Having completed the Blue Card process, prospective members Bill Wyers, Scott McClure, Anthony DuPree and Sonny Nowlon were introduced to the membership. A motion was made, seconded and passed unanimously to approve all for membership.

President's Business: President Ruth announced that the Planning Committee is working on a Project Plan to implement the recommendations of the Safety Committee to correct the bullet trajectory and ricochet safety issues at the Training Range. Following a several month-long analysis of the issues and evaluation of potential corrective options, the recommendations of the Safety Committee were ultimately influenced by an engineering study and the NRA's manual on range construction. (Details of these recommendations are covered in the BOD Meeting Minutes of June 17, 2020). The Board of Directors unanimously approved passing these recommendations along to the Planning Committee for Project Plan development and pricing during their June 17, 2020 meeting. Pursuant to the Club's Bylaws (Article V Section 2C), the completed Project Plan and cost will be communicated to the membership for consideration prior to a membership vote to approve the funds and proceed with the project. Communication of the Project Plan and cost will likely occur via email.

Membership News: Dir. Kloiber announced that Lois Shultz is in the hospital and Annette Krzus' father-in-law has passed away.

Meeting Adjournment: With no further topics introduced or agenda items to cover, Pres. Ruth entertained a motion, which was seconded and unanimously approved, to adjourn the meeting at 9:00 am.
