Repairs and Maintenance: The wireless units for Clay Bird payments are expected to arrive tomorrow. Once installed, the Payment Kiosk can be put online. G.K. Coleman reported that the wiring for the 5-Stand lighting has been installed and all is in place to install the light fixtures. President's Business: Pres. Ruth lead a discussion concerning the Club's 4th of July picnic. After thoughts and opinions on the matter were shared, a decision was reached unanimously that the picnic would be held with the traditional BBQ meal being served outside on the 100-yard range.

A proposal made by Pres. Ruth to save the Club \$1536 a year in contracted printing costs for the Club's monthly newsletter was agreed to on a trial basis. During the trial period, the copies of the newsletter made available to the membership at the clubhouse will be generated in-house by the Club's administrator.

A proposed amendment to the Club's By Laws that addresses the swearing in of newly elected offices in the event the annual Club Banquet is canceled was discussed. A motion was made, seconded and passed unanimously that this proposed amendment will be sent to the membership for approval once membership meetings are resumed.

New Business: No new business was introduced.

Meeting Adjournment: With no further topics introduced or agenda items to cover a motion was made, seconded and passed unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 7:55 pm.
